Qualified Riggers/Signalpersons

Mountain Crane employees are now Qualified Riggers and Signalpersons according to OSHA 1926.1400 effective February 8th in the state of Utah.

Earlier this month, Mountain Crane recently hosted a crane rigging and safety management course with presenters from Construction Safety Experts. The course covered safe rigging practices, selection and inspection of hardware and rigging, sling angles, hitches, center of gravity, wire rope use and inspection.

It also went over hand and radio signal communication, crane set up, crane inspection, leveling procedures, use of blocking and outriggers, ground stability, radius, boom length, boom angle, rated strength and stability.

Along with Signalperson and Rigger Qualifications, Mountain employees attended both extended reach and standard forklift equipment operator certification.

All the information presented was based on summaries and highlights of the manufacturer's recommendations, ANSI A10.42, best practices and ASME standards. Mountain Crane was very impressed with the instructors as well as the overall presentation.
