Commuter Rail Bag House

Mountain Crane recently completed a unique project that required the lifting capabilities of two cranes: our Liebherr LTM 1400 500 Ton All Terrain and Link Belt 348 300 Ton Crawler Crane. These two cranes had to work together in order to lift and transport a heavy bag house weighing over 180,000 lbs.

In order to complete this difficult lift, the Link Belt crawler had to travel backwards with the load as the Liebherr all terrain swung around into its position. We had several crew members on the ground to spot each crane and monitor site conditions.

Just before Halloween, Mountain Crane donated three large pumpkins as well as equipment and labor for a “snowman” display at Wheeler Farm.

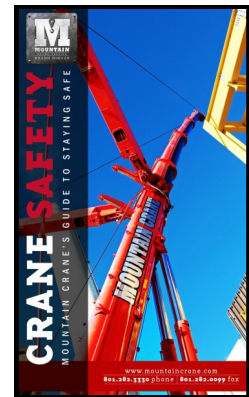
