Bushton, Kansas Crane Lifts

During the latter half of December, Mountain Crane Service completed several lifts at the One Oak Fractionator Expansion Project in Bushton, Kansas. There were three consecutive lifts over the course of three days.

The first two modules weighed 121,000 lbs. each and were lifted at a 130 ft. radius. The third lift weighed 165,000 lbs. at a 160 ft. radius. Each of these lifts was executed safely and efficiently.

The fourth and heaviest lift came in at 450,000 lbs. at a 84 ft. radius. This was significantly less weight than the lift had been planned for and the crane was originally configured for, which led to some minor complications.

Fortunately, Mountain Crane's talented team, led by Travis Horton, was able to work through the problem and complete the lift without any delay or difficulties.



Each of these lifts utilized a Demag CC2800 Crawler Crane with Super-Lift attachment.

We'd like to thank Barnhart Crane and Turner for their excellent team work on these heavy lifts.

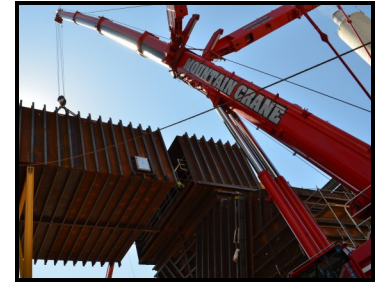
The past seven years of company ownership have been an adventure and he looks forward to many more years working with his friends and family.
